Candidates to the Merchant Marine Academy, located at Kings Point, New York, must be nominated by a Member of Congress from their state. Candidates must be academically and physically qualified. They must compete for available vacancies from their state and must meet the standards for an appointment as Midshipman, United States

Naval Reserve. Graduates are trained to be officers for United States merchant vessels; although the Academy is a federal institution, jobs in the merchant marine are privatesector employment.

Detailed information on applying is contained in the catalogues.
