1,461 were on hand Sunday at 2 p.m. to hear Mr. Beda climax the convention with the lecture, "How Does the Truth Affect Your Life?"

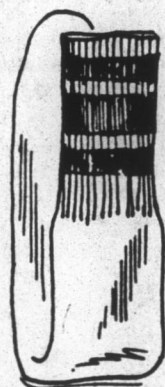

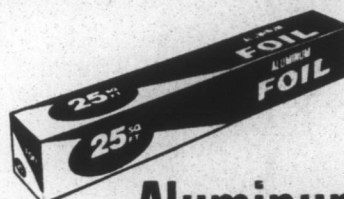
