

The wedding date has been set for Sunday, November 28, 1982 at 3:00 in the afternoon in the home of Mr. & Mrs. Murray L. Nixon.





When Wisdom Teeth Create Problems

If all of your wisdon teeth have erupted without causing discomfort and other concerns, you're one of the lucky ones. Wisdom teeth may cause serious dental problems if left to fend for themselves.

They usually erupt or come through the gums between the ages of 16 and 30, one in each of the rear four corners of your jaw. Not everyone develops all four wisdom teeth, however, and there are even some people who don't develop any wisdom teeth at all. But most people do, and the complications can be painful as well as detrimental to your dental health. Sometimes wisdom teeth become impacted because they don't have enough room to break through the gums (our ancestors had

bigger jaws to ac-comodate wisdom teeth). When this happens, they can throw your other teeth out of alignment. Sometimes they become infected, resulting in a painful and potentially hazardous abcess.

If your wisdom teeth are not causing any problems, perhaps they will not need to be extracted. But they should be checked carefully by your dentist and treated as needed to protect your dental health.
