After retirement from the Service he entered the ministry of Christian education and presently is serving as field representative for one of America's largest and finest Christian educational programs. During Rev. Yancey's ministry he has initiated ten Christian Schools, and is presently writing a column for the Hesperia News, entitled, "The Religion Report."

Rev. Yancey recently resigned his pastorate at Old Town Baptist Church in Hesperia and became evangelist for that church.
