

## Underpayments

nual interest rate charged by state. the Internal Revenue Service on tax underpayments and overpayments will decrease from 20 to 16 per cent on January 1, 1983.

The rate on the underpayment of individual and corporate estimated taxes will also slide into 16 per cent, the IRS said.

The interest rate is changed simi-annually by October 15 and April 15, and based on the average prime interest rate for the 6-month period ending September 30 and March 31, respectively. The next change in the interest rate, if any, will be made next April.


