

Compliance Is Requested

RALEIGH—The N.C. Department of Transportation Division of Motor Vehicles is working with the trucking industry, organizations and individual truckers in a cooperative effort to encourage compliance with the legal weight limits on North Carolina's highways.

The fall harvest season is underway and DMV is concerned that farmers may inadvertently overload their trucks. Overloaded trucks cause damage to the state's highways and create hazards to other motorists.

Motor Vehicles Commissioner R.W. Wilkins Jr. explained, "An education program has been initiated to educate truckers of existing legal weight limits, proper loading, and the achievement of even distribution of weights to meet legal requirements."

Truckers are required to comply with three different weight laws. First, a license plate must be purchased to cover the empty weight of the vehicle plus the maximum load carried. Secondly, the trucker must comply with axle weight laws. The third law establishes the maximum amount that a truck can weigh and this is determined by the number of axles.
