Batter: 2 eggs

3/4 c flour (self rising)

2 T water 1/2 t salt

Dip chicken in batter and deep fry in oil. Drain. Place in warm oven. Sauce:

1/2 c vinegar

2 c drained chunk pineapple 1/4 t Accent

3/4 t salt 1½ green pepper cut into

3 T catsup

strips 1 c water

1 c sugar 3 T cornstarch

2 T oil Dash pepper Mix well. Bring to a boil.
