 assurances that the new law would not mean more time off for state employees. The obvious lawmakers were assured by the bill's principal sponsor, Rep. Ken Maulding, a Democrat of Durham and the legislative back caucus leader. The "recognized holiday" has been explained to mean at the King birthday will be as much as Jewish holidays observed, but not closing down state offices. Still, there was a grunted sense of rebound among those opposed to additional holidays for state lawmakers or for whatever reasons. "The State Personnel Commission might be able to bring it now, (a day off with the "holiday" designation)," said one opponent, "Besides, with them (the legislators) still in town, anything can happen."

Gov. Jim Hunt's DUI proposals got off to a fairly smooth beginning, with no signs of an opposition roundswell.

There will be compromise enough, as evidenced by the ready compromise age limit for buying beer and wine. Instead of the first scussed age of 20 or 21, the governor's proposals reached the Assembly at age 19.

Secretary of Crime Control and Public Safety Heman Mark allowed that the moderate change should alleviate any problems of enforcement or disrespect for the law, especially around college campuses, that might result if the age was raised to 21.

The first tax revenue bill to gain attention was Sen. George Marion's expected alcohol tax increase, Marion, Democrat from Surry County, is usually on the forefront of such action involving liquor.

The senator's bill would raise the tax on liquor and wine by a third and would add 1/2 cents per can on beer. The likes of the bill are estimated to bring in \$10 million for the general fund—less five per cent to be distributed to the counties on a per capita basis.

Sen. Marion's bill, however, apparently isn't exactly what Gov. Hunt has been looking for in recent weeks to raise money for matching highway funds from the federal government.

According to press aide Brent Hackney, "the governor is in sympathy with Sen. Marion's bill to the extent that it might be a starting point to helping highways." Hackney said Marion and Hunt had discussed the bill earlier in the week, but the governor had "held out on making any kind of commitment."

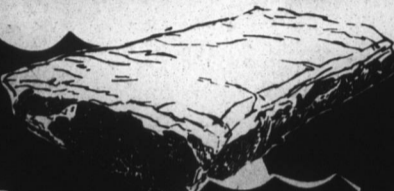
