Melvin Daniels, Jr. Appointed To Budget Commission

Lieutenant Governor Jimmy Green today announced the appointment of Senator Melvin R. Daniels, Jr., of Elizabeth City to membership on the Advisory Budget Commission. He also re-appointed

Senators Conrad Duncan, Jr., of Durham to membership on the Commission. Their terms will run two years.

In naming Senator Daniels to the Commission, Green called him "a fine legislator

whose background and experience in the business world, and especially in the banking profession, will add much to this Commission's work. I know that this part of the State will be well represented, and that pleases me, too."

Senator Daniels has served in the North Carolina Senate since the 1975 Session. During the 1983 Session, he chairs the Senate Committee on Small Business. He represents the First Senatorial District, which is comprised of Camden, Currituck, Dare, Hyde, Pasquotank, Perquimans, and Tyrrel Counties, as well as parts of Beaufort and Washington Counties.
