

# James Is New Chairman

WINSTON-SALEM — Dr. Frances M. James III has been named chairman of the Department of Anesthesia at the Bowman Gray School of Medicine. The appointment was effective January 1.

He succeeds Dr. Thomas H. Irving who has been head of anesthesia at the medical center for the past 15 years. Irving asked to be relieved of his administrative duties in order to return to full-time teaching and patient care.

Dr. Richard Janeway, dean, commended Irving for "the magnificent job he has done in developing the department. The program is recognized as one of the strongest in the nation."

Janeway said James was appointed chairman following a national search "for the best possible person to lead the department in its continued development."

James joined the Bowman Gray faculty in 1969 after two years on the faculty of the University of Pennsylvania School of Medicine. He was promoted to professor in 1977 and the following year was appointed head of the Section on Obstetric Anesthesia.

He is a past president of the Society of Obstetric

Anesthesia and Perinatology. He is a contribution editor of *Obstetric Anesthesia Digest* and was co-editor of the book "Obstetric Anesthesia: The Complicated Patient."
