The review also found 1983 truck renewal cards that were mailed indicated a 15-day grace period. This is in error since all annual truck renewals for trucks licensed for 5,000 lbs. gross weight and above should have been completed by February 15, 1983. These vehicles, operating after February 15, must display 1983 tags. Vehicles which are not currently registered for 1983 would ordinarily be issured a citation for 1983 license fees and assessed a civil penalty, ac- taken to correct the printing cording to DMV officials.
