# **Scholarships** Are Available

According to George Stokes, Veterans Service Officer for Chowan County, the Norus Carolina Division of Veterans Affairs, headed by Charles A. Beddingfield, Jr., administers the State's program of scholarships for children of certain veterans.

Each year more than 700 children apply for the scholastic aid offered by this fine program. Nearly 500 awards were made last year and it is estimated that 1,600 children are enrolled each year at 117 institutions in North Carolina.

The following information is necessarily general in nature. There are several classes of scholarship eligibility. Briefly stated they are:

Classes I & IV. Children of certain veterans who died or are 100 per cent disabled as a result of service in WW I, WW II, Korea, Vietnam, or children of peacetime veterans whose death or 100 per cent service-connected disability was incurred (1) as a direct result of armed conflict or (2) while engaged in extra-hazardous service or children of certain veterans who were POW/MIA. Vet must have been a legal resident of North Carolina at the time of entry into service, or with certain exceptions, the child must have been born in North Carolina and continuously resided here.

Class II. Children as described above whose parent was a vet of WW I, WW II, Korea, Vietnam, or a peacetime vet whose disability was incurred (1) as a direct result of armed conflict or (2) while engaged in extrahazardous service. The vet must have or at the time of death had a 30 per cent or more but less than 100 per service-connected cent disability or a statutory for award arrested tuberculosis.

Class III. Eligible children as described above whose parent was a veteran of WW I, WW II, Korea, or Vietnam. Veteran rated and recieving or at the time of death receiving 100 per cent nonserviceconnected disability benefits.

The scholarships may be used at schools located in North Carolina which are: 1) State owned institutions of higher education, community colleges and technical institutes; or 2) privately owned non-profit colleges and

Scholarships, with one exception, provide free tuition, certain fees, and a room and board allowance in State owned institutions and \$1,200 per academic year in private institutions. The exception being that awards under the 100 per cent service-connected disability provision provide only free tuition and certain fees in State owned institutions and \$444 per academic year in private institutions.

All awards are four academic years in duration. Unlimited awards are made under Clases I & IV. Classes II and III are limited to 100 awards each year in each class.

Applications should be made between September 1 and May 1 of senior year in high school. Class I or IV applicants will accepted at other times as well.

## Fishermen May Be Exempted

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Rep. Walter B. Jones, chairman of the Merchant Marine and Fisheries Committee, has introduced a bill, H.R. 1895, which would permanently exempt certain fishermen from the Federal Unemployment Tax (FUTA).

With the enactment of the 1976 Tax Reform Act, owners of fishing vessels were permanently exempted from paying Federal withholding income taxes and FICA (Social Security) taxes for fishermen on their vesses! if the vesse! was manned by less than ten crew members and if
