Block Commended For Decision To Provide Funding

Sen. Jesse Helms of North Carolina, chairman of the U.S. Senate Agriculture Committee, commended Agriculture Secretary John Block for his decision to re-allocate funds to provide FmHA operating loans. Sec. Block announced that he is re-allocating \$400-million in lending authority to the Farmers Home Administration's operating loan program to satisfy an immediate need farmers have for such loans. He is using the Secretary of Agriculture's interchange authority to deal with a need that became necessary after 17 states exhausted their allocations of FmHA operating loans.

"The secretary has wisely used the internal authority he has to provide these necessary funds to farmers at a critical time," said Helms. "The funds will come from programs with less urgent needs. With spring planting upon us, it is imperative that this money be made available to farmers immediately. Undoubtedly, the FmHA operating loan program is the most urgent and immediate needs farmers have at the moment."

The interchange includes \$75-million from FmHA water and sewer grants, \$100-million from the FmHA farm ownership program, and \$225-million from FmHA water and sewer loan funds. Total funding for these programs is \$275-million in the FmHA water and sewer grants fund, \$700-million in the farm ownership program, and \$825-million in the water and sewer loan fund.

"What people need to understand is that other programs are not being short shrifted as a result of this move, said Helms. "The funds are being re-allocated from money recently added to these programs. Communities with needs under these water and sewer programs will continue to have those needs met."

"The secretary's action demonstrates a judicious use of limited funds," said Helms. "He has correctly identified operating loans as the most immediate need, and allocated the available funds to the item of highest priority. I think this action is a move of courage not often seen in this town."

"At the same time, the Secretary has assured farmers that they will continue to receive funds necessary to meet their production expenses. Since loan applications have continued to come in through the short-fall, there will be no interruption in the granting of loans by FmHA, and planting can proceed on schedule."

Peoples Bank Issues Report To Its Shareholders

ROCKY MOUNT—The annual shareholders meeting of Peoples Bancorp (N.C.), Inc. was held at the bank's Main Office in Rocky Mount on April 20.

Chairman and Chief Executive Officer, William H. Stanley reported that the bank grew to record size during 1982. Total assets reached a new high of \$473,136,000 as of December 31, 1982, compared to \$442,178,000 on the same date in 1981. Total deposits reached a new high of \$402,879,000, a 10 per cent increase over the year before. Gross loans for the bank reached a record high of \$272,514,000 versus \$252,027,000 reported in 1980. The bank's net income after security transactions were \$4,729,000. On a per share basis, this amounted to \$3.42 compared to \$3.37 in 1981.

During this report, Chairman Stanley indicated "in 1982 the deregulation of financial institutions accelerated and threw banks into greater competition, not only with other banks, but also with other types of financial organizations." To counter this increased competition, Stanley reinforced the bank's commitment to its market. Most significantly, the agreement reached with NCNB National Bank of North Carolina in December to purchase six of the merged Bank of North Carolina Branches in Wilmington and two NCNB branches in Jacksonville was concluded in the first quarter of 1983. "This significant acquisition represents a milestone in the bank's history," concluded Stanley. "Not only has the bank exceeded \$500,000,000 in assets, but also positions the bank to provide full financial service to all of Eastern North Carolina with 59 offices serving 31 communities."
