Sweet Potatoes

The U.S. Department of Agriculture announced on April 25, 1983 an offer to buy canned sweet potatoes packed in 1982 or later.

Although a purchase of approximately 200,000 cases is anticipated, actual quantities purchased by USDA will depend upon offers, prices and user requirements.

Offers must be in by June 1, 1983. Shipments shall be made from August 1, 1983 through September 30, 1983.

The N.C. Yam Commission has worked hard to get this supplemental purchase. This makes a total 752,000 cases from the 1982 crop of sweet potatoes for the child nutrition programs.

More school children will get to enjoy delicious and nutritious North Carolina sweet potatoes.
