

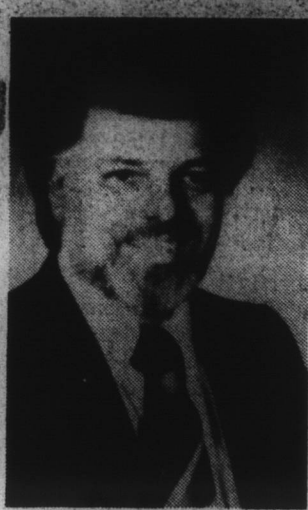
## Conference To Hold Meeting

FAYETTEVILLE — The N.C. Conference of the United Methodist Church will convene here at Methodist College June 5-9 to determine actions and ministries for the future. More than 1,500 delegates—one half clergy and one half laity—are expected to attend this Annual Conference. Of particular importance will be the election of delegates to next year's

General and Jurisdictional Conference, as the United Methodist Church marks its 200th Anniversary in 1984.

Presiding over the proceedings will be Bishop William R. Cannon, Raleigh Area bishop and Chairman of the Executive Committee of the World Methodist Council. Cannon served the conference from 1968-72 and returned in 1980.

The five-day event begins Sunday with an ordination service, in which Bishop Edwonn C. Boulton, resident bishop of the North Dakota Area, will preach. Both Deacons and Elders will be ordained during special evening services. Annual Conference continues through Thursday morning. At the close of the conference, Bishop Cannon is expected to read the appointments of the ministers for the 1983-84 year. United Methodist pastors are assigned every year, with approximately 170 receiving new appointments. Moving day for pastors is June 16.

## Rust To Speak At Assembly Of God

"Heaven on wheels," is just one of the tags used to describe Sam Rust's rolling chapel and his ministry to truck drivers across the country. A refurbished tractor-trailer rig serves as his church where he talks safety and salvation to the nation's truckers.

An ordained Assemblies of God minister and an industrial chaplain, Rust says there are millions of "18-wheelers" rolling on America's highways, 45 per cent of them with two drivers. Their schedules often cut off these people from regular church attendance or opportunity to find spiritual help, he says.

So he's doing something about it. Trucking company owners and executives give Rust clearance to go to their docks with his safety program. They understand and agree that the last 10 minutes of the precisely timed one-half

hour presentation will be given to spiritual emphasis. The chapel is equipped with 8 minipews, a lectern, and a movie screen. It also has a kitchen and bunk up front.

As the drivers come aboard, usually at the change of shifts, Rust tells them of the 26-minute film they are about to see, "I hope you get something out of it that will save your life on some rain-slick highway." He also tells them that after the film, "I will be driving for your eternal souls."

Rust uses a Bible verse,

truck driving terms, and highway anecdotes to address the personal and spiritual needs of the drivers. "Safety is a matter of life and death," he says. "Safety is of the Lord." he quotes from Scripture. And he explains that God is concerned about every area of their lives—that through His Son Jesus Christ He is ready to help.

Rev. Rust will be the special speaker for the 11:00 A.M. worship service at First Assembly of God, Business 17 South (Queen St. Extd.) on Sunday, May 29th. The mobile

chapel will be on the church premises. Time for a visit to the facility will be made available. Pastor Gloekler invites all to attend.

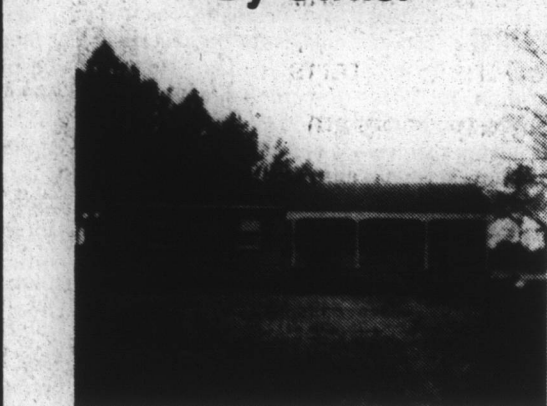
