NORTH CAROLINA WILDLIFE RESOURCES COMMISSION Notice of Hearing

In accordance with Sections 143B-18 and 150A-12 of the General Statutes of North Carolina, notice is hereby given that the North Carolina Wildlife Resources Commission will conduct public hearings at 11:00 o'clock A.M. on June 16, 1983 in Room 386 of the Archdale Building at 512 N. Salisbury Street, Raleigh, North Carolina, for the purpose of soliciting public reaction to the proposed water safety regulations as follows:

1. Restrict boats to no-wake speed in that portion of the Chowan River immediately adjacent to the Arrowhead Beach Subdivision Park in Chowan County, and prohibit entry of boats into a swimming zone located within the area.
2. Restrict boats to no-wake speed in Indian Creek adjacent to Arrowhead Beach Subdivision in Chowan County.
3. Restrict boat speeds near launching ramps and other facilities on Harris Reservoir in the Counties of Wake and Chatham, prohibit entry of boats into danger areas of the reservoir, and limit height of boat rigging to prevent contact with high-voltage power lines.

The foregoing proposals were made pursuant to authority contained in Chapter 75A of the General Statutes of North Carolina, to become effective on August 1, 1983.

Interested persons may express their views either orally or in writing at the hearing or prior to the hearing by communicating with the Wildlife Resources Commission, Archdale Building, 512 N. Salisbury Street, Raleigh, North Carolina 27611.
