Kimley - Horn and Associates, Inc., a Raleigh engineering and planning firm, has been cited by the state's private engineering firms for outstanding work on the U.S. 17 Corridor Study.

The study, sponsored by the N. C. Department of Transportation, examine the feasibility of improvements along the entire route of U.S. 17 in North Carolina, from the Virginia border to the South Carolina border.

The department commissioned the study with the goal of arriving at a phased implementation program -- a step-by-step plan for improving U.S. 17 beginning with those areas where need was greatest

North Carolina consulting engineers selected the study as the state's entry in national competition.

Kimley-Horn was cited for the combination of its technical engineering study of the area's transportation meeds and its strong public participation program, which measured both rural and urban opinion and needs regarding the four-laning of the corridor.

Under the department's direction, Kimley-Horn first educated the public on the types of four-laning improvements available, from a simple four lane with uncontrolled access to a controlled




