Bill Introduced

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Rep. Walter B. Jones of the First District of North Carolina, has introduced in the U.S. House of Representatives a Joint Resolution calling for the national commemoration of the 400th anniversary of the first English attempts to settle in America, at Roanoke Island.

Drafted with the assistance of the State Committee created in 1973 to organize the observance, and with the cosponsorship of the entire delegation of North Carolina representatives, the Jones Resolution asks the President to designate the years 1984 through 1987 as a period of national observance of this historic event. The first activity planned for the celebration is set for April 27, 1984, in Plymouth, England, to commemorate the sailing of Sir Walter Raleigh's first expedition. In this country, activities will begin on July 13, 1984, with the dedication of a marker on the shores of North Carolina near the site where the English first landed, the commissioning of a reproduction of one of the settlers' ships — the "Elizabeth II" —, the issuance of a commemorative stamp, and a special performance of the play "The Lost Colony". The celebrations will conclude on August 18, 1987, the 400th anniversary of the birth of Virginia Dare, the first baby born to English parents in America.

"Our country has a fascinating history that when brought to life through activities such as those planned for this 400th anniversary celebration, can educate and entertain thousands. Because the events we will commemorate are so important to not only North Carolina but to all of America and even reaching to our allies across the Atlantic, I have introduced this resolution to grant national recognition to, and encourage national participation in, our efforts," said Chairman Jones.

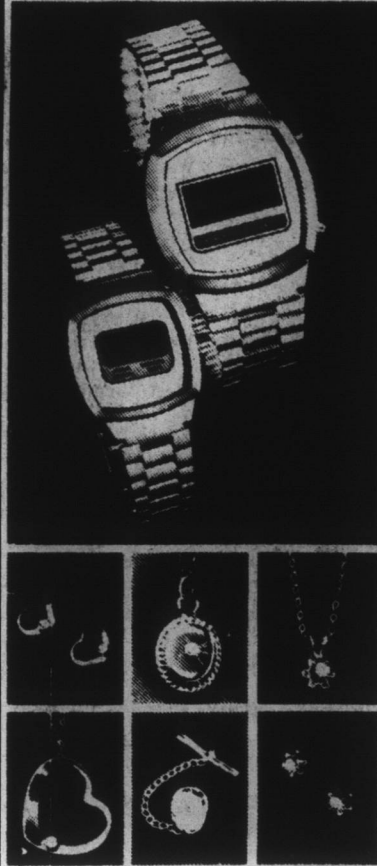
