like CT Scanners", Latimer said. And they'll work together under the network umbrella to provide other non-profit hospitals broader access to scarce resources and expertise spanning management, patient care, finance, education, and hospital operations.

"Network affiliations offered to community hospitals

equipment maintenance and group purchasing to the actual operation of hospital facilities by one of the several non-profit multi-hospital systems in the network. Several offer contract management, lease, and purchase arrangements that present sound alternatives in the voluntary sector", Latimer said. "Emphasis will continue to be on flexibility and

hospital choice of relationships", Latimer added.

"Aggregately, the network's founders operate more than 25,000 owned, leased, or managed beds in approximately 100 facilities, and have existing cooperative relationships in place with more than 400 other hospitals in the region. Community

hospitals already sharing services through CHHS or one of the other founder organizations have an existing, built-in relationship with SunHealth Network", Latimer said. In the Carolinas, Georgia, Alabama, Kentucky, and Iowa, CHHS provides selected shared services for hospitals under existing relationships with state hospital associations. "These programs will continue", Latimer added.

SunHealth, Inc., which operates the network, is a new independent non-profit corporation headquartered in Charlotte, N.C. Its initial

board of directors, to be self-perpetuating in the future, was selected by the boards of the Sun Alliance and the CHHS corporation, which plans to become a SunHealth affiliate.

## Social Security Report

Brides, along with anyone else who had a recent name change, should contact the Elizabeth City Social Security office to arrange to have their names changed in Social Security records and to apply for a new Social Security card showing their new name. Unless the bride plans to continue using her maiden name after marriage, Social Security records should be changed so that any earnings she may have are properly reported to the correct record.

To apply for a new Social Security card, which will show the bride's new name but the old Social Security

number, she should submit evidence showing her old and new names, a marriage licence for example.

Only original documents or copies certified by the issuing agency are acceptable. Uncertified photocopies are not acceptable.

After acceptable evidence is submitted, it will take about 2 weeks to issue the new Social Security card.

This service is provided free by Social Security; you do not have to pay anyone to do it for you.
