 MONTGOMERY.—By a vote of 58 to 11, the Alabama house last Saturday passed a bill which will allow Senator Oscar W. Underwood to elect Alabama's delegates to the national democratic convention.

Canoeists Paddling to New Orleans
 MOORHEAD, Minn.—Headed for New Orleans, Frank Sadler and Stanley B. Day, Winnipeg, arrived here Saturday by canoe from Winnipeg. Their route is down the Red river, over Lake Traverse and Big Stone and down the Minnesota river to the Mississippi. They expect to make New Orleans by the first of year.

Mitchell Palmer and Bride Tour Europe
 NEW YORK.—A Mitchell Palmer attorney, present in the administration of President Wilson, sailed on the Olympic Saturday with his bride and about 200 guests. Mr. Palmer predicted the election of a National Democratic administration and that the next president of the United States would be either William G. McAdoo, Senator Balkin, of Indiana, or Senator Underwood, of Alabama.

Two Killed in Accident To Big Steam Shovel
 ALBEMARLE, N. C.—Walter Johnson, of this county, and Joe Finney, of Clinton, S. C., were instantly killed here last Wednesday when the cable to one of the steam shovels, owned by the Asheville Paving company, broke, allowing the shovel, filled with crushed stone, to fall upon the two men. The men were employed by the company in street paving here.

Coca-Cola Earnings
 ATLANTA, Ga.—The Coca-Cola company's quarter ended June 30, reports net income \$1,871,246 after expenses, but before federal taxes equal after deduction of preferred dividends to \$3.29 a share of \$500,000 shares common to par. This compares with \$2,755,925 or \$5.19 a share on common in June 1922 quarter.
