

One of the early fears - that DDT would destroy too many bees which are useful as honey collec- cated. tors and particularly valuable as pollenizers of crops such as le umes and fruit - has been virtually eliminated by the discovery that DDT is actually less deadly to bees than the arsenical sprays now monly used. Beekeepers now are beginning to regard DDT as a presiming relief for bee losses by trente poisoning.


