

More people were killed by accidents in farm homes alone last year than were killed in the great Chicago fire, the sinking of the Titanic, the San Francisco earthquake and fire, and the Johnstown flood combined.

People do not hear much about the accidents that occur in the farm home. Many of them do not get into the papers. And yet that is the scene of the greatest number of farm accidents. National Safety Council figures indicate that nearly 7,500 farm home fatalities occur each year.


There are many suggestions in this week's advertising columns for observance of safety rules, to make the farm and farm home safer places to work and live, and readers are urged to take note of these suggestions.
