Bicolor Lespedeza Seedlings Still Available

The North Carolina Wildlife Resources Commission still has about 2,500,000 bicolor lespedeza seedlings available free of charge to cooperating farmers and sportsmen. Clyde F. Patton, Executive Director of the Commission, says. In spite of dry weather last summer, the Commission produced 4,000,000 seedlings in its Sandhills Area nursery, and about half of these are still unsubscribed. To obtain free seedlings which will grow to food-bearing size by next fall, interested persons need only to send a postal card to the Wildlife Resources Commission, Box 2919, Raleigh. Field biologists in each of the nine districts are responsible for distribution of the seedlings, and when feasible will make direct contact with persons requesting seedlings to facilitate delivery and give advice on plantings. Most shipments are made in lots of 2,000 seedlings, although more may be obtained where large tracts of land are to be improved for farm game cover and food. In addition to the bicolor seedlings, 2-pound packets of sericea lespedeza seeds are delivered. These are to be planted next to the bicolor to provide nesting cover for small game such as quail and rabbits. Both bicolor and sericea lespedeza may be planted during winter months before general farming operations begin. Seeds and seedlings are available to 4-H and FFA groups wishing to use wildlife habitat development as club and chapter activities.

Breeders Attend Session Friday

A representative of Murphy Milkshed Artificial Breeders Assn., Inc. met with the State Policy Committee of the Southeastern Artificial Breeding Association at City Hall, Statesville, Friday at 10:30 a. m. Henry Vanatory of Statesville, President of the State Policy Committee, called this meeting to order. The Policy Committee is made up of one member selected from each cooperative or breeding service purchasing semen from the Southeastern Artificial Breeding Association, an American Breeders Service organization. Various matters of policy were discussed and voted upon by these representatives. Policies of the American Breeders Service stud at Asheville are determined by its customers, who make up the 113 cooperatives and breeding associations in 7 southeastern States, which are furnishing dairymen served from the delectable service sires of the ABS stud. Most of the directors and officers

of the North Carolina, South Carolina, Virginia associations attend this meeting. American Breeders Service representatives from Michigan and North Carolina were present. The Extension Dairymen from the respective State Colleges and County Agents were invited.
