Franklin is a member of Phi Delta Kappa, national educational fraternity, The National Principals' Association, Florida Education Association, National Education Association and The Association for Childhood Education. He is a member of the Ley Memorial Methodist Church, the American Legion, the Key West Lions Club, and the Monroe County Audubon Society.

He has been active in Scouting and summer recreation programs for elementary children. Since coming to Florida he has participated in the Evaluative Criteria Program for Elementary Schools.

During World War II, he served thirty-seven months with the Ninth Air Force, being stationed in Egypt, England and France.

Mrs. Franklin is the daughter of J. B. Shields of Marble. She taught in Murphy Elementary School in 1942-1945. At present she is teaching in Harris Elementary School, Key West, Fla.
