**JOHN PAUL LUCAS, JR. Is Nominated Rotary Governor**

John Paul Lucas, Jr., head of the public relations department of Duke Power Company of Charlotte, has been selected as governor of the 28th District of Rotary International as its nominee for district governor President. Wayne Battle was advised recently by Rev. Malcolm R. Williamson, of Waynesville, present district governor.

Lucas' election was conducted by mail preliminary to the district conference to be held in Shelby April 17-19. Appointment of Dr. Gerald Almond as On-To-Shelby chairman for the conference was announced also by President Battle. A sizeable local delegation is expected to attend the annual get-together.  
The formal election of Mr. Lucas will occur at the annual convention of Rotary International in Mexico City May 25-29, in form of ratification by the board of directors of the choice of this district. Governor-elect Lucas will attend the International Assembly at Lake Placid, N. Y., which will precede the Mexico City Convention.

Formerly engaged in newspaper work, Mr. Lucas was also in academic life for a time. He served successively as a master at Asheville School, a member of the psychology department at North Carolina State College and on the English faculty at Clemson. He has written extensively. An active Methodist, the new Rotary governor occupies positions of leadership in patriotic, civic, economic and cultural spheres.  
Composed of 35 clubs and a combined membership of 1722, the 28th district includes the part of North Carolina west of the eastern boundaries of Alleghany, Wilkes, Iredell, Mecklenburg and Union.
