Presbyterians Hold Picnic

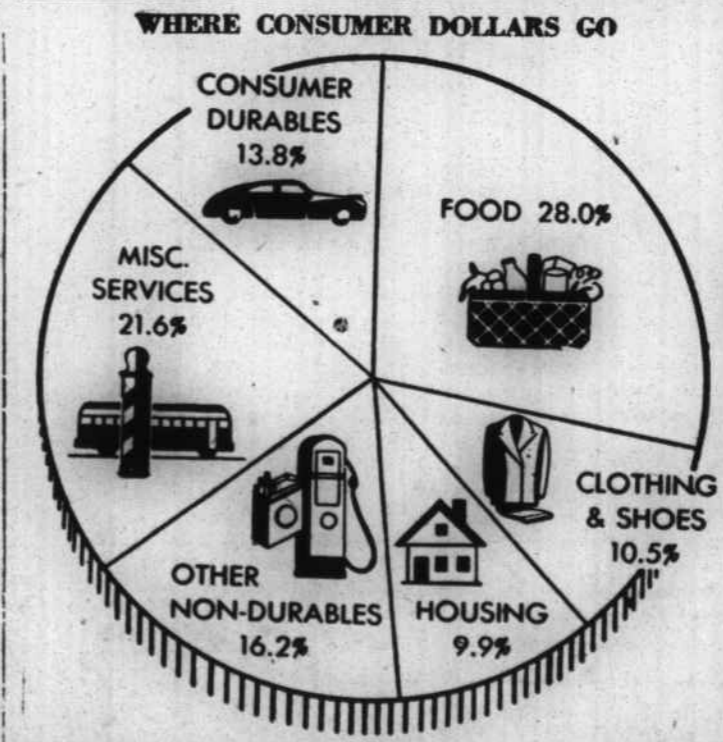
The Andrews Presbyterian Sunday School held their annual picnic at the Nantahala Picnic Area Tuesday evening, July 21.
