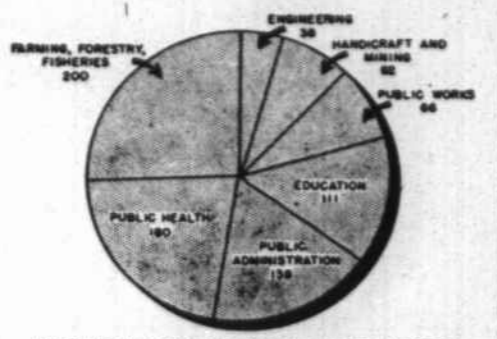

Young Succumbs To Long Illness

James Henry Young, 77, a farmer, died at 1 p. m. Friday, August 15, at the home of a daughter, Mrs. Joe Teague, Route 3, Blairsville, Ga., after a long illness.

He was a member of one of the oldest families in Union County, Ga. His great-grandfather came to this country from Germany and was given a land grant.

Funeral services were conducted in Providence Methodist Church, of which he had been a member for more than 50 years. The Rev. John Cook officiated and burial was in the church cemetery with Ivie Funeral Home in charge.

Grandsons, Miles and Floyd Payne, Randal Teague, Franklin Young, C. L. Christopher and James Dill, served as pallbearers. Surviving are two sons, Alvin and Will of Blairsville; six daughters, Mrs. Mary Forrester, Mrs. Aline Teague, Mrs. Alma Dills, and Mrs. Lena Payne, all of Blairsville; Mrs. Grace Christopher, and Mrs. Dessie Fox of Gastonia; 40 grandchildren and 29 great-grandchildren.

Officers Capture Stills Near Suit

Two stills were captured near Suit by Buren Grant, chief deputy sheriff of Cherokee County, and Roy Reese and Clarence Heaton, both Federal men, today (Thursday).

The stills were close to each other, one a 60 gallon still and the other a 45 gallon still. The officers destroyed 100 gallons of peach jamice at the 60 gallon still. Corn whiskey had recently been made at the other one.

Grant stated that no one was at the stills and no arrests were made.

Officers have not yet ascertained ownership of the property. Grant says investigation is incomplete.

The number of young chickens raised this year and the number of layers on hand June 1 indicate a smaller laying flock on January 1, 1953 than existed a year earlier.

Generally, U. S. farms need about four times as much lime and about five times as much superphosphates as they are now getting. Under Secretary of Agriculture Clarence J. McCormick says we need four times as much strip-cropping, about five times as much green manure and cover crops, and about 30 times as much contour farming as is now done.

Forty-two per cent of North Carolina's total corn acreage was planted with hybrid seed in 1952, as compared with 38 per cent in 1951.

On July 1, farm wage rates, without room and board, averaged 57 cents an hour for the country as a whole. The average in the South was from 54 to 64 cents.
