

### Mrs. Daly Dies In Athens, Tenn.

Mrs. Mary Clemens Daly died early Thursday morning, October 23, in the home of her son-in-law and daughter, Mr. and Mrs. A. C. Huber in Athens, Tenn., following an illness of several months.

Mrs. Daly was well known here having lived here for three years when Mr. and Mrs. Huber operated the Regal Hotel.

Born June 1, 1864 at Defiance,

Ohio, she was the daughter of the late Mr. and Mrs. Jacob Clemens. While a young girl the family moved west via covered wagon, over the Oregon Trail and settled in Boise, Idaho Valley where her father homesteaded. They were among the earliest settlers in that region. A few years later she was married to Isaac N. Daly, and was the mother of seven children.

In 1906, the Daly family moved to the Province of Alberta, Canada where Mr. Daly had become interested in a cattle ranch. He died in 1915, after which Mrs. Daly

lived on the ranch with one of her sons until 1929 when she came to Murphy to make her home with Mr. and Mrs. Huber.

Leaving Murphy, Mr. and Mrs. Huber and Mrs. Daly moved to Athens, Tenn., where Mr. Huber leased the Robert E. Lee Hotel and operated it for 17 years.

Funeral services were held Friday at 10:30 a. m. in Mars Hill Presbyterian Church of which she was a member. The pastor, The Rev. J. Graham Spurrier was officiating minister and elders and
