Don't learn traffic rules by acc-t." was the word today from actor Turvia Jones of the State ne a personal war on North Heads HD Club to deaths and injuries.


The safety chief bolstered his est fatalities and injurthe flat statement that ng last year caused the st number of deaths on the ways with reckless driving close behind

In 1952, Jones said, there were 40,117 cases of speeding and 18,-134 of reckless driving. Speeding alone caused the greatest number of fatility

"That's why knowing and obeying traffic laws is so important, Jones continued. Seventy-eight per cent of all fatal accidents involved at leaste one violation of a traffic law.

We refer to the fact that people can make laws designed to keep them safe and free from accidents, and then turn around and break every one of the laws they or their represenatives have made for their own protection."
