By virtue of authority vested in me by a judgment of the Cherokee Superior Court dated November 4, 1952 in the above entitled action, I will on Wednesday the 13th day of May, 1953 at 12:00 o'clock Noon at the Courthouse Door in Murphy, North Carolina, offer for sale to the highest bidder for cash the fol-

lowing described property in the Town of Murphy:  
**TRACT NO. 1:** In the Town of Murphy, adjoining the Ivie Furniture Company and the Savage Hotel, and being commonly known and referred to as the Lay & Company 5c & 10c Store Building. Being Lot No. 3 in the Town of Murphy, fronting 30 feet on Main or Peachtree Street and running back 93 feet to a 16 1/2 foot alley as shown on the map of the Duke Land and Improvement Company on file in the Office of the Register of Deeds for Cherokee County in Plat Book 1 at page 6.  
**TRACT NO. 2:** In Murphy Township, adjoining the lands of R. F. Roberts, Posey Crisp, the Mack Carringer Heirs, and others and bounded as follows: BEGINNING on an Ironwood on the North bank of Hiwassee River and runs up the river a Northeast course 73 poles to a small locust; thence N 54 W 110 poles to a small black oak in the line of R. F. Roberts and Mack Carringer Heirs; thence a south course with said line to Posey Crisp line; thence with said Crisp line to the beginning. Said Crisp line and said Carringer line being designed by iron poles.  
**TRACT NO. 3:** In the Town of Murphy.
