Hanging Dog Creek on the lower or West bank of the road as originally located, being west of the road as now located, and in the B. F. Lovingood line (now Carl Gentry) and runs with the bank of the road leading from Grandview to Unaka in a South direction to where it strikes the Creek; then cross the road with the line of a lot of land conveyed to J. W. Lovin-good by J. W. Patton and the top of a ridge a North East direction to the top of the main ridge to a stake in the B. F. Lovingood line (now Carl Gentry); then with said line a Westerly direction to the Be-ginning. And being the land de-scribed in a deed from D. W. De-weese and M. E. Deweese to O. C. Davis, and registered in the Office of the Register of Deeds for Chero-kee County in Book No. 29-85, at page 336, to which reference is hereby made for a more complete description of said land.

And being the same land described in a deed from J. B. Mulkey and Iona Mulkey to Fred Davis, and registered in Book 97 at page 301.
The above described boundaries being the lands conveyed to Rob-ert Marcus and wife Lucile Marcus by Charles McDonald and wife Vey McDonald in deed dated October 12, 1946 which said deed is rec-orded in the Office of the Register of Deeds for Cherokee County in Deed 45-4tc

Book 159 at page 256, reference to which is hereby made for a more complete description of said lands.
Being the same lands described in a deed dated November 28, 1947 from Robert C. Marcus and wife, Lucile Marcus to Vester L. Kent, recorded in Book 185 at page 277, reference to which is hereby made. This the 14th day of May, 1953.
