NOTICE OF INTENTION TO APPLY TO THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT COMMISSION FOR APPROVAL OF BONDS

NOTICE is hereby given of intention of the undersigned to file application with the Local Government Commission, Raleigh, North Carolina, for its approval of the issuance of the following proposed bonds of the Town of Murphy, which bonds shall be subject to approval of the voters of said Town at an election:

\$190,000 of bonds for the purpose of reconstructing, enlarging and extending the water supply system maintained by the Town to provide a supply of water for the town and its inhabitants and the acquisition of the land or rights in land, furnishings, equipment or apparatus constituting a part of such reconstruction, enlargement and extension.
This notice was published on the 14 day of July, 1953. Any citizen or taxpayer objecting to the issuance of all or any of said bonds may file with the Local Government Commission a verified statement setting forth his objection as provided in Section 159-7.1 of the General Statutes of North Carolina, in which event he shall also file a copy of such statement with the undersigned, at any time within ten days from and after such first publication. A copy of this notice must be attached to the statement so filed. Objections set forth in said statement shall be for consideration by said Commission in its determination of whether or not it may hold a public hearing as provided by law on the matter of issuance of said bonds.
