NOTICE OF SPECIAL ELECTION AND OF NEW REGISTRATION OF VOTERS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a SPECIAL ELECTION will be held in the town of Murphy, North Carolina, on the 22nd day of November, 1955, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified voters of said town, for their approval or disapproval, the following proposition:

Shall the qualified voters of the Town of Murphy approve the bond ordinance which was adopted by the Board of Commissioners of said town on July 5, 1955, and which (1) authorizes bonds of said town of the maximum aggregate amount of \$190,000 to finance the cost of reconstructing, enlarging and extending the water supply system maintained by said town to provide a supply of water for said town and its inhabitants, and acquiring the land or rights in land, furnishings, equipment, machinery or apparatus constituting a part of said improvements or

properties at the time of said reconstruction, enlargement and extension, and (2) authorizes the levy and collection of an annual tax sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on said bonds; and also approve the indebtedness to be incurred by the issuance of said bonds.

The polls for said election will open at the hour of 6:30 o'clock, A. M., and will close at the hour of 6:30 o'clock, P. M., Eastern Standard Time. The polling place for said election shall be the usual polling place in the Town of Murphy, to-wit: Courtroom of the Cherokee County Courthouse.

The Board of Commissioners of the Town of Murphy has appointed Jennie Lee Sneed to act as Registrar, and WILL ROGERS and JOHN O'DELL to act as Judges of Election for said election.

NOTICE IS ALSO HEREBY GIVEN, that a new registration of the qualified voters of the Town of Murphy for said election has been ordered by the Board of Commissioners of said town. The Registrar will keep open the book for new registration from 9:00 o'clock, A. M. until 6 o'clock, P. M., on each day, except Sundays and holidays, for three weeks, beginning on Saturday, the 12th day of October, 1955, and ending on Saturday, the 12th day of November, 1955, being the second Saturday before said election. On each Saturday during the registration period said book will be kept open at the polling place above named.
