Mrs. Sara Posey Morgan, associate professor of secretarial science at Alabama College, has been awarded an all expense fellowship to the six-week economics in action summer program at Case Institute of Technology, Cleveland, Ohio. Daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Garland Posey, Mrs. Morgan is a former resident of Murphy. Only 50 fellowships are awarded each year to this program which is designed for college and university teachers of economics and social science.

Mrs. Morgan holds degrees from Asheville College and the University of Tennessee, Knoxville. She is a member of Pi Omega and Sigma Alpha Sigmas, honorary fraternities in the fields of Business Education and Secretarial Administration and the American Association of University Women.

**Highway Conditions Bulletin Released**

The Highway Conditions Bulletin for May, released recently by the State Highway & Public Works Commissions, listed the following detours near this section.

Not included in the bulletin are county roads serving local traffic primarily, and State projects which do not affect the normal flow of traffic.

The detours West of Asheville are: U. S. 19 West of Bryson City, Project 9806, 2.7 miles grading, structures, and paving, complete 7-15-56. Traffic maintained over construction. Slow.

U. S. Franklin-Ga. line, Project existing paved route and through Traffic maintained temporarily

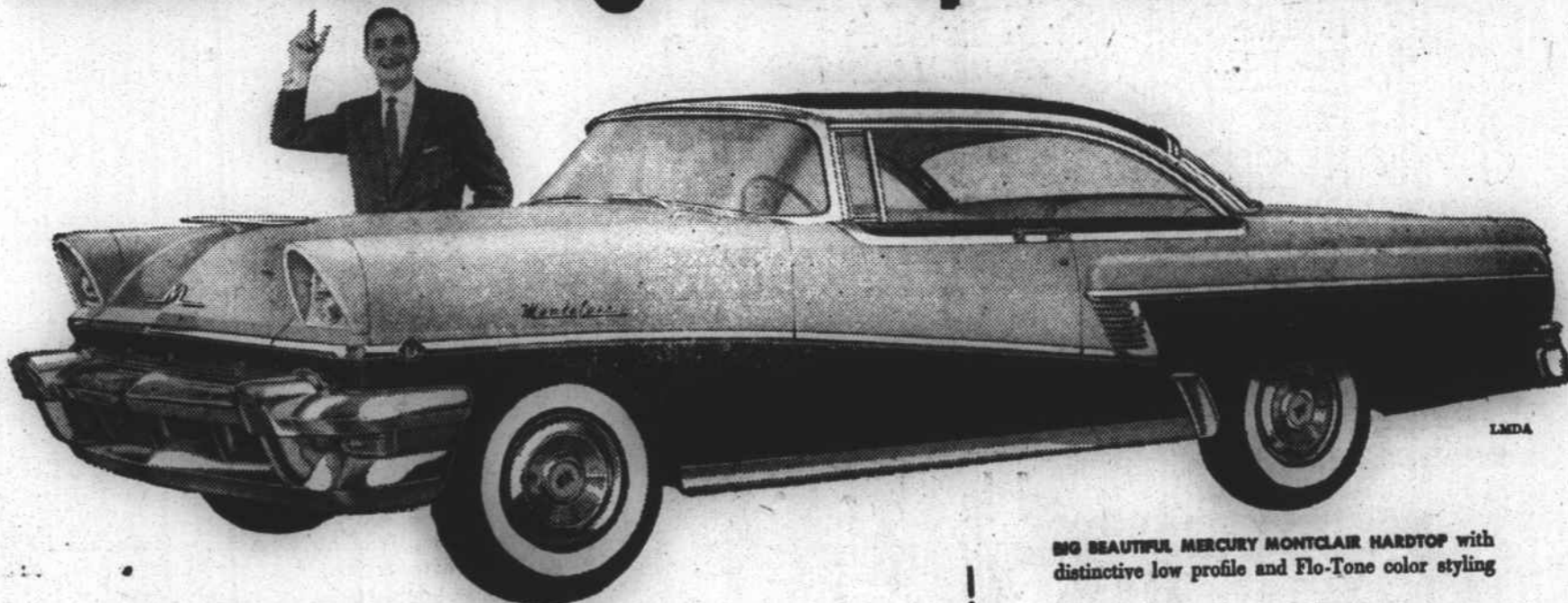
