

NORTH CAROLINA CHICK PLACEMENTS
 During the week ended December 28 there were 1,399,000 chicks placed with broiler growers in North Carolina. This compares with a total of 1,315,000 placed during the preceding week. Placements in the Central Western areas totaled 1,329,000 last week compared with 1,264,000 during the week before.
 Hatcheries in the State set 1,768,000 eggs for broilers last week compared with 2,211,000 set the week before. For the same period broiler chicks hatched totaled 1,687,000.
