ADVERTISING FOR BIDS

Sealed Proposals will be received by the Clay County Board of Education at the office of the County Superintendent of Schools, County Courthouse, Hayesville, N. C. until 3:00 p.m. Thursday, March 28, 1957, for furnishing all materials and labor for construction of a new Gymnasium located at Hayesville, N. C.

All bids will be publicly opened and read at the time stated and proposals received after the hour and date specified will not be considered.

Separate bids will be received on General Contract, Plumbing Contract, Heating Contract and Electrical Contract.

Plans and specifications will be placed on file at the A. G. C., F. W. Dodge, or the builders exchanges in Charlotte, N. C., Columbia, S. C., Greenville, S. C., Atlanta, Ga., and Greensboro, N. C., or may be obtained from the office of Gilmer Harrill, Architect-Engineer, Box 356, Andrews, North Carolina upon deposit of \$40.00 as security. All plans deposits will be refunded in full to all Prime Contractors, all sub-contractors, and all material suppliers provided bona fide bids are submitted for any part of the work. Plans deposit will be returned provided plans are returned to the Architect in good condition within ten days after bids are received.

No proposals will be considered from contractors who do not hold proper state licenses governing their respective trades. All proposals shall be accompanied by a deposit of cash, a certified check on a bank or trust company insured by the F. D. I. C., or an acceptable bid bond executed by a corporate surety licensed under the laws of the state of North Carolina, in the bid. The cash, check or bid bond shall be submitted conditioned upon the furnishing of proper performance bond for the work and the execution of the contract by the successful bidder within ten (10) days after the award of the contract. In the event the successful bidder can not furnish proper performance bond or does not execute the contract within the specified time the bid depositor bid bond will be considered forfeited to the owner as a measure of damages. In the event that the surety does not forthwith make payment where bid bonds are used the surety will, in accordance with state requirements, be obligated to pay the owner an amount equal to double the amount of the surety bond.

Performance bond will be required for the 100% of the contract amount. Bids may be withdrawn up to the scheduled closing time.

The owner reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive informalities.

Butter-Bread Pudding Nutritionally Rich

Just as the old adage, "the proof is in the pudding", says the proof of this pudding lies in its nutritive value and its richness in eggs and milk.

Do you have trouble getting your family to drink milk or eat their egg a day? If so, try this pudding recipe in order to supplement their diets with needed vitamins and minerals:

- 6 slices day-old bread
- 1/2 cup butter
- 4 eggs
- 1/2 cup sugar
- 1/4 teaspoon salt
- 1 teaspoon vanilla
- 1 quart milk
- 3/4 cup seedless raisins
- 1/2 teaspoon cinnamon

Toast bread lightly on both sides and cut each piece into three strips

Farmers in the United States marketed 2 to 3 per cent more products in 1956 than in 1955. One-third of all the free-cured tobacco allotments in North Carolina are of two acres or less.

Using a mulch in the home garden will do at least five good things: conserve moisture, control weeds and grass, protect roots, prevent water run-off, and keep vegetables cleaner.

In a rectangular baking dish (12 x 1 x 1-1/2 inches), and pour the melted butter over them. Repeat, making second layer of buttered toast beat eggs slightly, add sugar, salt, vanilla, and 1 cup milk. Scald rest of milk and stir into egg mixture. Pour over bread in baking dish, and sprinkle with raisins and cinnamon, pushing bread down until it starts to absorb liquid.

Bake in a slow oven, 300 degrees for 50 to 60 minutes, or until a sharp knife inserted in the center comes out clean. Be careful not to overbake. Serve warm or cold, with cream if desired. Makes six servings.

In addition to the protein in the eggs, the calcium and many other nutrients in the milk, you get additional iron in your diets from the raisins in this recipe.

Farmers Given Opportunity To Enroll In Group Ins.

Farm people in Cherokee County and vicinity who have not yet enrolled in the Farmers Federation's Blue Cross Group hospitalization program with Hospital Care Association of Durham, will have a special opportunity to do so beginning this week.

The special enrollment will continue through Monday, April 15. Persons who enroll during this time will be covered as of April 15.

All farm families in Cherokee County and 16 other WNC counties in the Farmers Federation service

area are eligible to enroll during this special campaign. Age limit at time of enrollment is 65 but subscribers may keep their coverage beyond that age.

The family certificate offered in the current enrollment provides hospital and surgical protection, including maternity coverage.

Anyone who is interested in getting Blue Cross protection is asked to visit their local Farmers Federation store or contact the nearest volunteer worker.
