Some food freezers need defrosting between complete clean-ANSWER: You can control this ings. This is particularly so of frost faster than the chest type. For this in-between defrosting,

hold a tray or cooky sheet tight against the wall of your freezer and scrape frost onto it with your plastic scraper. This scraping can often be done without removing foods - or at most with a little rearranging of them.

While doing your cleanup is a good time to lay plans for your coming freezer load. To do this, you'll need to analyze your family's eating habits. For example, if your family likes peas for dinner once a week, it's smart to plan to freeze enough to include them in your menus this often.

It's also smart to plan for a turnover in your supply of frozen foods. Rapid turnover means improved quality and economical use of freezer space.

Another good idea is to lay in a supply of wrapping materials and containers after you've planned your coming freezer program, You'll know what kinds you'll need and won't be caught short when you start filling your freezer.
