FARM QUESTIONS

QUESTION: What are the advantages of polled dorset sheep over other breeds?

ANSWER: The new strain of polled dorsets has received a lot of attention lately. Actually, the fact that they are polled, while their ancestors had horns, is what makes them more useful and easy to handle. Horns make shearing more difficult, sometimes grow into the head, and frequently get caught in women wire fences and farm equipment. And polled animals require less feed bunk space and are not subject to infestation by the horn worm.

QUESTION: How much of the beef consumed in North Carolina is produced in this state?

ANSWER: Home slaughtered beef amounted to about 2 per cent of the consumption in the state in 1958, or roughly 6 million pounds. Of the estimated 282 million pounds of beef purchased through retail outlets in North Carolina last year only about a fifth came from cattle produced and slaughtered in this state.

QUESTION: Just where does North Carolina stand as beef-producing state?

ANSWER: Although cattle production as increased considerably in North Carolina in recent years, the state still remains a relatively minor producer of cattle. In 1958 cattle and calf production amounted about 125 million pounds, one-half of 1 per cent of the total U.S. production.
