Local Man Takes Part In Operation "Deepfreeze"

Alman Second Class Meritt Ramsey, son of Mr. and Mrs. J. S. Ramsey, Murphy, N. C., has arrived in Christchurch, N. Z. for Operation Deepfreeze V. He is one of the 400 MATS men chosen for Deepfreeze the aerial resupply of the U. S. scientific stations in the Antarctic. During the next three months he will serve with the 9th Troop Carrier Squadron of Donaldson AFB's 63 Troop Carrier Squadron. The 9th earlier named the MATS unit to airlift tons of supplies from Christchurch, New Zealand, to McMurdo Sound, Antarctica during the Spring season September through mid-December in the Southern Hemisphere. MATS men and planes, C-124 Globemasters, have been airlifting and airdropping supplies in the Antarctic since the early preparations for International Geophysical Year studies near the South Pole in 1956.
