WHAT IS AN INDULGENCE?

Last week Johnny broke his dad's fishing pole in temper. Because he was really sorry, later on, his father did forgive him. But he also placed a penalty on John, as a punishment or penance, or as a slight punishment for this incident. "John, you may not go to the movies for four weeks." Well, John's boy friend whispered to him, and they both hurried outside, cut the grass, and chopped kindling wood that afternoon. They washed the basement windows, burned the papers and emptied the garbage.

Of course, his dad was pleased with this extra voluntary effort, of personal penance, you might call it. And he did go easy on the boy. He was indulgent; he reduced the penalty to 2 weeks instead of four. Johnny's friend helped him gain a 2 week's indulgence.

Now an indulgence in the religious sense means the same thing. For instance, our Lord said, "Ask and you shall receive." We in this world, need this extra hour of Bible reading, or this service to my neighbor or this donation for our church needs. Be indulgent to me or to my friend. We are sorry for our past ingratitude. We promise to do better. Please accept this penance as reparation and atonement, which is rightfully due to you.

I shall offer this on behalf of myself and even of my deceased friends and relatives.

In turn, we believe that our Lord will hear that prayer, and be indulgent or grant an indulgence to our loved ones, thus shortening any waiting period they may have to spend, before entering heaven. Last week we saw that a play goes on where a man who is truly sorry for his sins, can prepare himself and can pay himself, before entering the pure vision and life of God.

We who are still on earth may pray to our Lord to be indulgent toward such a one, to accept our reparation, and grant an indulgence, or a shortening of his preparation period before entering heaven.

Holy Scripture speaks of the easy Christians who were baptized for the dead, as their way of gaining indulgences for them. Read this reference in St. Paul, First Corinthians, Chapter 15, Verse 29. Some men today preach private interpretation of the Bible for themselves, but it is humorous to hear those same men deny the majority of Christians the right to believe in the scriptural interpretation of Purgatory. These men deny that the Catholic Church is infallible, but they make themselves infallible by rejecting, absolutely, the traditional interpretation of these gifts of God's mercy.
