Sealed bids will be received by the Mayor and Board of the Town of Murphy, North Carolina, at the City Hall until 2:00 p.m., Thursday, February 25, 1960, for the construction of Water Works Improvements for the Town of Murphy, North Carolina, at which time they will be publicly opened and read.
The work will consist of the construction of a 100,000 - Gallon Steel Reservoir with the necessary foundations, and the necessary pipe connections for the new Reservoir.
Plans and Specifications and Contract Documents are open to public inspection at the Town Clerk's Office, Murphy, North Carolina; the office of the Associated General Contractors, Charlotte, North Carolina; and at the office of the Engineer, W. K. Dickson & Company, Inc., 404 1/2 South Tryon Street, Charlotte, North Carolina, or may be obtained from the Engineer upon deposit of \$10. The full amount of this deposit will be returned to each actual bidder. Additional sets will be furnished at one - half price but deposits for additional sets will not be returned. Machinery, equipment, or material suppliers, who need complete plans for submitting proposals, will also be furnished plans at one - half price. These deposits will not be returned.
No bids may be withdrawn after the scheduled closing time for the receipt of bids for a period of 30 days.
Each proposal must be accompanied by a deposit equal to 5 per cent of the gross price bid, this deposit consisting of cash or a Cashier's Check issued by or a Certified Check drawn on a Bank or Trust Company authorized to do business in North Carolina or on a Bank insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation, or a U. S. Money Order, payable to the Town of Murphy, North Carolina, or a Bid Bond issued by an Insurance Company authorized to do business in North Carolina; said deposit shall be retained by the Town of Murphy in the event that the successful bidder fails to execute a formal contract within ten days after notice of award is given, or fails to give satisfactory surety as required in the Instructions to Bidders.
General Contractors are notified that "An Act to Regulate the Practice of General Contracting" will be observed in receiving bids and awarding general contracts.
