### LEGAL NOTICE

#### LEGAL NOTICE NORTH CAROLINA CHEROKEE COUNTY TOWN COUNCIL ORDERS STRICT ENFORCEMENT OF PARKING ORDINANCES:

NOTICE TO ALL MOTOR VEHICLE OPERATORS WHO PARK WITHIN THE REGULATED PARKING AREAS OF THE TOWN OF MURPHY.  
At the request of the local businessmen and due to a need of an effective method of regulating parking in congested areas on the streets of Murphy regulatory ordinances were passed and parking meters of a type which should be most appreciated by the public were installed.  
The Merchants Association at our last regular board meeting stressed the urgency of the strict enforcement of our parking ordinances.  
The board has ordered strict enforcement of the parking regulations. To avoid the embarrassment of being brought into Court as a habitual violator of the parking ordinances we solicit your cooperation.  
EXCERPTS FROM THE TOWN OF MURPHY PARKING ORDINANCES:

WHEREAS, the General Statutes of North Carolina, Chapter 160, Sections 200, Sub-Section 31, as amended; 160-501, and other laws of the State of North Carolina, authorize and empower municipal corporations to regulate and limit vehicular traffic and parking in certain areas within the municipality, in which the congestion of vehicular traffic is such that public convenience and safety demand such regulation; and  
(1) On the Public Square,  
(2) On both sides of Peachtree Street from the Public Square to Alpine Street.  
(3) On both sides of Tennessee Street from the Public Square to a point on said street at which Dickey-Crane Wholesale building is located.  
(4) On both sides of Valley River Avenue from the Public Square to the Methodist Church.  
(5) On both sides of Hiwassee

Street from the Public Square to Sycamore Street, and  
(6) On both sides of Church Street from Hiwassee Street to McLelland Street,  
in said town shall be two (2) hours (except that 4 parking spaces on Hiwassee Street in front of the United States Post Office shall be 15 minutes) on each and every day between the hours of 8:00 o'clock A. M. and 6:00 o'clock P. M., except on Sundays and Holidays; and,  
WHEREAS, it is also the opinion of the Council that in order to promote public convenience and safety a system of parking meters should be used in the regulation of vehicular traffic in said congested areas; and,  
WHEREAS, the governing body of the City of Murphy has caused to be installed parking meters at or near the curbs on the public square and streets as hereinabove designated, which parking meters shall be maintained by the City of Murphy in good working order.  
Section 5. PARKING TIME LIMITS.  
(a) It shall be unlawful and constitute a violation of this ordinance for any person to park or stand a vehicle in a designated space in a parking meter zone for a period of time in excess of two (2) hours between the hours of 8:00 o'clock A. M. and 6:00 o'clock P. M., except Sundays and holidays.  
(b) It shall be unlawful and constitute a violation of this ordinance for any person to park or stand a vehicle in one of the four (4) designated fifteen (15) minute parking spaces in the park-meter zone in front of the United States Post Office on Hiwassee Street for a period of time in excess of fifteen (15) minutes between the hours of 8:00 o'clock A. M. and 6:00 o'clock P. M., except Sundays and holidays.  
Section 6. OPERATION OF PARKING METERS. When any vehicle shall be parked in any parking space alongside or next to which a parking meter is located in a parking meter zone, the operator of such vehicle shall, between the hours of 8:00 o'clock A. M. and 6:00 o'clock P. M., except Sundays and holidays, upon entering the said parking meter space, immediately set in operation the timing mechanism on such meter by depositing or causing to be deposited in said meter such proper coin, or coins, of the United States as is required for such parking meter and as is designated by proper directions on the meter, and failure to set the timing mechanism in operation as required, shall constitute a violation of this ordinance. If said vehicle shall remain parked in any such parking space beyond the parking time limit for such parking space, then, and in that event, the operator of such vehicle shall be considered as parking overtime and beyond the period of legal parking time, and such parking shall be deemed a violation of this ordinance.  
Section 7. VIOLATIONS. It shall be unlawful and a violation of the provisions of this ordinance for any person:  
(a) To cause, allow, permit, or suffer any vehicle registered in the name of, or operated by such person to be parked overtime, or beyond the period of legal parking time established for any parking meter zone as herein described, or to deposit in any parking meter any coin for the purpose of parking beyond the maximum legal parking time for the particular parking meter zone.  
(b) To park any vehicle on any street in the City of Murphy in front of a fire hydrant or to park any vehicle on any street in the City of Murphy except in a space marked off for parking.  
(c) To park any vehicle across any line or marking of a parking meter space or in such position that the vehicle shall not be entirely within the area designated by such lines or markings.  
(d) To deface, injure, tamper with, open or willfully break, destroy, or impair the usefulness of any parking meter installed under the provisions of this ordinance.  
(e) To deposit or cause to be deposited in any parking meter any slugs, device or metal substance, or other substitute for lawful coins.  
Section 10. PENALTY. Any person who shall violate or fail to comply with any of the provisions of this ordinance, or who shall counsel, aid or abet any such violation or failure to comply, shall be deemed guilty of an offense and shall be punished by a fine of not to exceed \$50.00 or by imprisonment for not to exceed 30 days.

(b) It shall be unlawful and constitute a violation of this ordinance for any person to park or stand a vehicle in one of the four (4) designated fifteen (15) minute parking spaces in the park-meter zone in front of the United States Post Office on Hiwassee Street for a period of time in excess of fifteen (15) minutes between the hours of 8:00 o'clock A. M. and 6:00 o'clock P. M., except Sundays and holidays.  
Section 6. OPERATION OF PARKING METERS. When any vehicle shall be parked in any parking space alongside or next to which a parking meter is located in a parking meter zone, the operator of such vehicle shall, between the hours of 8:00 o'clock A. M. and 6:00 o'clock P. M., except Sundays and holidays, upon entering the said parking meter space, immediately set in operation the timing mechanism on such meter by depositing or causing to be deposited in said meter such proper coin, or coins, of the United States as is required for such parking meter and as is designated by proper directions on the meter, and failure to set the timing mechanism in operation as required, shall constitute a violation of this ordinance. If said vehicle shall remain parked in any such parking space beyond the parking time limit for such parking space, then, and in that event, the operator of such vehicle shall be considered as parking overtime and beyond the period of legal parking time, and such parking shall be deemed a violation of this ordinance.

(c) To park any vehicle across any line or marking of a parking meter space or in such position that the vehicle shall not be entirely within the area designated by such lines or markings.  
(d) To deface, injure, tamper with, open or willfully break, destroy, or impair the usefulness of any parking meter installed under the provisions of this ordinance.  
(e) To deposit or cause to be deposited in any parking meter any slugs, device or metal substance, or other substitute for lawful coins.  
Section 10. PENALTY. Any person who shall violate or fail to comply with any of the provisions of this ordinance, or who shall counsel, aid or abet any such violation or failure to comply, shall be deemed guilty of an offense and shall be punished by a fine of not to exceed \$50.00 or by imprisonment for not to exceed 30 days.
