## Announces Job Openings

Immediate job openings for prison guards in this vicinity were announced today by Jack A. Wilson, manager of the Employment Security Commission local office.

The local office manager said the drive to recruit guards in this area is part of an effort taking place all over the State to fill 130 new guard positions in the Prison Department. The new guards will begin work on July 1 in 31 Prison units scattered over the State.

After passing initial screening, applicants will be interviewed on June 21 by a committee from the Prison Department. These interviews will take place at ESC offices in Elizabeth City, Greenville, Wilmington, Wilson, Durham, Fayetteville, Greensboro, Asheville, Winston-Salem, Albemarle, North Wilkesboro, Lincolnton, Hendersonville and Asheville.

Salaries for the jobs begin at \$3,132 and rise to a maximum of \$3,996 annually.

The ESC manager said all applicants should be between the ages of 21 and 45, in good physical shape, with at least an eighth grade education (high school preferred), and have no police record of arrests. All applicants will be required by the Prison Department to pass a short series of screening tests to be administered by the ESC, the manager said.
