Words of Life

'CATCH THE LITTLE FOXES' In the second chapter of the Song of Solomon we find these words, 'Catch us the foxes, the little foxes, that spoil the vineyards.' No one would be surprised if this verse is placed in the context of a passionate love story. But whatever prompted the writer to put the verse there, it is a bit of wisdom that points to our need for mastering the little things of life, the little foxes which slip unnoticed past our defenses and destroy the vineyards. When we face the big problems we keep our guard up. We use all of our means and ability to overcome the big obstacle. But the real threat to our health and to the condition to our soul comes from the little things. One of the little foxes that is destroying the influence of the individual Christian today is hypocrisy. Hypocrisy in any sense is bad. It is bad when we pretend to be better than we are. But the most destructive hypocrisy of today is pretending to be worse than we are. It is the hypocrisy that makes us give outward approval to action and activities that we cannot accept inwardly. If we are with a crowd, no one wants to be the 'odd ball' so everyone goes along. A few months ago nine boys in a Texas town broke out 300 windows in a new school building. These boys came from some of the finest homes in the town. Before they were tried the judge had an outstanding psychologist interview each of the boys separately. He reported that not one of the boys approved the action of the group. But every single boy expressed that firm conviction that he was the only one in the group who felt that way. Each boy thought that all the other boys felt that their action was right. Their group committed a crime which none of them approved. Everyone of them contributed by pretending to be worse than he was. This story is symbolic of our society today. The little fox of pretense and hypocrisy makes Christian people afraid to speak up, afraid to stand with hearts uncovered for the right. Another little fox that destroys our soul is the refusal to look at reality, the refusal to look objectively at the world about us. We will be surprised at the absurdity of our fears and resentments when we face them square-
