BOOK REVIEW
"Dr. Tom Dooley"
 By Thomas A. Dooley, M. D.

 Sensationalism is not to be found in this autobiography in which Dr. Tom Dooley explains his work in Indo-China to the young people of America. Illustrated with sixteen pages of photographs, this book is an abridgement of three books by the author, **DELIVER US FROM EVIL, THE EDGE OF TOMORROW,** and **THE NIGHT THEY BURNED THE MOUNTAIN.**
 In 1954, Tom Dooley, Lieutenant Junior Grade in the U. S. Navy, was assigned the job of building camps for refugees who had escaped the communist rule in North Viet Nam. (Under French Dominion until 1954, Laos, Cambodia, and Viet Nam made up Indo-China.)

is God on earth and that a doctor's job is to cure sometimes, to relieve often, and to comfort always." In this way, one got to know God a little better because of the solitude.

This is indeed a rewarding story told with great humility and straightforwardness. Seldom does one find such devotion to duty and self-sacrifice of personal pleasures. Why? In Dr. Dooley's own words, "...because we want to do what we can for people who ain't got it so good."

Polio Still A Danger, Shots Needed

After his naval duty was over, Dr. Dooley, a disciple of Dr. Albert Schweitzer, decided to return to Indo-China on his own to establish hospitals and to give medical aid to the underdeveloped countries. This project was the beginning of a non-profit organization called "Medico." Children at the orphanage of An Lac provided entertainment for Dooley's team at Haiphong. War did not have time to take care of babies, children became old very young and learned to accept adult responsibilities without questioning.

Behind the Bamboo Curtain, Dr. Dooley witnessed such communist atrocities as nails driven into skulls, tongues slashed with bayonets, and ear drums punctured with chop sticks.

Believing the future of humanity will be won—or lost—with the "have nots" in South-west Asia, Dr. Dooley has built a bridge that may one day link nation to nation.

Oaos was a beautiful country with its deep gorges and big clouds rolling slowly up the slopes of the high rain-forest. Yet, in the green valleys, huddled dirty, thatched huts wherein squatted the sick, the old, and the wretched.

In spite of the monotony of treating the same diseases and soothing the same miseries of human suffering, Dr. Dooley and his team did not let their own personal discomforts stand in the way of the work to be done. Helping to salvage some vestige of human dignity in a land where even living sometimes becomes an effort, Dr. Dooley remembered "that humanity

"Polio is still a danger in our community, and protective immunization must be maintained," says Dr. W. S. Cann, Health Director of Cherokee-Clay-Graham Health District. Dr. Cann cautions parents of small children that polio remains a hazard in our community. He explains that as more and more children and adults in our District are protected against polio by immunization, those without the protection of injections have less opportunity to build immunity against the disease. Consequently, children without immunization are unprotected from the polio virus infecting them, and the disease may be more severe and its effects more serious.

Dr. Cann further stated that a complete series of three injections is needed for adequate protection against polio. In order to maintain protection, periodic booster injections are necessary. He urged parents to be sure their children have had all the necessary immunizations. He added that they should contact their physician for further information.

For the State of North Carolina, five additional cases of polio were reported during the week ending September 10, 1960. The total cases in state for the January 1 to September 10 period now stands at 53 of which 27 are paralytic type. Last year in the same period 144 cases were reported; 122 were of the paralytic type.

At the moment Salk Vaccine remains the best agent offering protection against polio.
