LEGAL NOTICE TOWN OF MURPHY CHEROKEE COUNTY NORTH CAROLINA
On motion of Commissioner F.C. Bourne, Jr., seconded by Commissioner John Jordan, the following Resolution was introduced:

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWN OF MURPHY
WHEREAS, on the 1st day of July, 1961, the property owners on that portion of Van Horn Street from Ralph Rhodes or Boulevard Street 290 ft. up Van Horn Street filed with Town Clerk a Petition for improving said street by paving same 16 feet wide from Ralph Rhodes or Boulevard Street and 290 feet up Van Horn Street;

WHEREAS, the Town Clerk has certified to this Board that said Petition is sufficient in all respects, the same having been duly signed by a majority in number of the owners, who also represent a majority of all the lineal feet of frontage of the lands abutting upon the street or portion of a street above described;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it Resolved by the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Murphy:

(1) That the abovementioned Petition is found to be sufficient in all respects.

(2) That the part of Van Horn Street lying from Ralph Rhodes or Boulevard Street 290 feet up Van Horn Street be improved by paving same 16 feet wide under and by virtue of Section 160-78 of the General Statutes of North Carolina, 1943, as amended and the procedure thereunder, and that said improvement be done by Contract.

(3) That Two-Thirds (2/3) of the total cost of said improvement be hereafter assessed upon the lots of the street described herein, exclusive of so much of the total cost as is included in improving the Street Intersections, according to the extent of their respective frontages by an equal rate per foot of such frontage.

(4) That the assessment herein provided for shall be payable in cash or if the property owner should so elect and give notice of the fact in writing to the Town Clerk in accordance with the Provisions of Section 160-92 of the General Statutes as amended, he shall have the option and privilege of paying the assessment in 5 equal annual installments. Said installments to bear interest at the rate of six per cent per annum.

(5) That this Resolution shall be published in The Cherokee Scout on the 20th day of July, 1961.
