UL - These Letters Drop Unnecessary Losses

How many times a day do you turn an electric switch? Most of us do so hundreds of times, without giving a passing thought to the fact that the growing number of electrical appliances in every home could be breeding places of fire.

Two major steps are necessary to cut down the risk from fire in wiring and electric appliances. The first step will be discussed this week. See next week's column for the second step.

Make certain that all of your electrical appliances and wiring carry the familiar label that signifies that it has been tested and approved by the Underwriters' Laboratories.

Underwriters' Laboratories is the major testing station of the insurance business, operating the largest private laboratories of this type in the world. Founded by the capital stock fire insurance maintained by fees from its testing work, it is visited by scientists and students from all parts of the world.

To Underwriters' Laboratories come thousands of products from hundreds of manufacturers, where they are put through the most exacting tests.

For example, electric cords must pass drastic tests. Some approved cords must stand up after being twisted 10,000 times while a constant current of electricity goes through them. A fire door may be subjected to 2,000 degree heat. An electric hand iron is heated continuously for three weeks, then dropped to the floor from every position.

So it is with all products being tested -- from household hand irons, extension cords, refrigerators and industrial oil furnaces to commercial drink and food dispensers.

Products which meet the UL tests are labeled or otherwise designated -- a service that normally exceeds 100 million labels a year. Approximately 50 per cent of the original investigations undertaken by the laboratories reveal the necessity for changes in products to bring them into con-

formance with the requirements of established standards of safety. Approvals of Underwriters' Laboratories, known as "listings" are contained in regularly published pamphlets. These lists, widely circulated, make known the results of UL work to all interested persons.

This entire function is a contribution to public welfare. It affects practically every individual in the United States, whether or not he or she ever bought a nickel's worth of insurance.
