## New School Board Elections Ordered In Lumberton

It's official. The U.S. District Court in Fayettevillehas ordered new elections for
three members of the Lumberton School Board in reponse to a ruling last fall that found Lumberton in violation of the 1965
Voting Rights Act. signed by U.S. District Judge W. Earl Britt, who helped defend Lumbertor before being named to the federal bench by then President Jimmy Carter. on the as yet unannounced date for statewide primary elections.
The ruling stems from the illegal annexations in the late $60^{\prime}$ 's and 70 's of
the Barker Ten Mille, Lakewood Estates the Barker Ten Mile, Lakewood Estates,
and Clyborn Pines-Country Club sections by the Lumberton City Schools. Local parents filed suit, through the auspices of Lumbee River Legal Services and the American Civil Liberties Union, Under the most recent ruling, only residents of the Lumberton School District, excluding the illegal annexa tions, can participate as a voter or
