NOTICE OF GENERAL ELECTION

Notice is hereby given that a general election will be held in Robeson County on Tuesday, November 2, 1982, to elect Federal, State and County Officers.

All voters registered with the Robeson County Board of Elections are eligible to vote in the general election. Voters are already registered to vote and need not re-register to vote in this election. Residents of the county who are not registered to vote must register by Monday, Oct. 4, 1982, to be eligible to vote in the general election. Also, a voter who has moved since the last election must notify the Board of Elections of that change by the same date. A person may register to vote at the Board of Elections Office at 108 West Elizabethtown Road, (across from the county jail) Lumberton, North Carolina, between 8:15 a.m. and 5:15 p.m. on Monday through Friday, or by a Precinct Registrar or Judge in the county.

Any voter who will be out of the county the entire time the polls are open on election day, or who will be unable to go to the polls because of sickness or physical disability, may vote by absentee ballot. The voter may apply for an absentee ballot beginning on Friday, September 3, 1982. Application must be made in person or in writing to the Robeson County Board of Elections. The deadline for applying for an absentee ballot is 5:00 p.m., Thursday, October 28, 1982.

Legal Services of the Lower Cape Fear is seeking a licensed attorney to work in the Wilmington office of Legal Services of the Lower Cape Fear.

The Program--Legal Services of the Lower Cape Fear is a legal aid program rendering civil legal assistance to indigent individuals in eight southeastern North Carolina counties. Legal Services of the Lower Cape Fear provides advice and counseling to the 130,000 eligible clients it serves in the predominantly rural eight counties of southeastern North Carolina, while concentrating its litigational and representational capacities in the areas of public benefits, education and job training, housing and housing development. This attorney will spend the majority of his or her time in representing indigent individuals and groups in the eight counties served by this program. Additionally, this attorney will render general assistance through a Telephone Assistance Project to persons in a multiplicity of legal areas. There is an emphasis on legal education for low-income people, and all attorneys are expected to assist in this area.

Presently there is a central office in Wilmington, North Carolina. The primary method of service and intake is through a toll-free assistance number staffed by a licensed attorney each day, and providing the general assistance for a balanced program to the client population. The legal staff of the program consists of four attorneys and two paralegals.

Job Qualifications

The position now open is for a person able to practice in the courts of North Carolina, and be licensed at the time of application. A background

and commitment in providing assistance in bettering the lives of low-income people will be given strong preference.

The Area

Wilmington, North Carolina, a town with a significant historical past, is located on the southeastern coast of the state, approximately seven miles from the Atlantic Ocean, bordered by the ocean and tidal areas to the east and the Cape Fear River to the west. Some members of Legal Services have chosen to live in the historic district-a renovated section of Old Wilmington-while others have chosen to live at the adjoining beaches. Outdoor activities in the immediate vicinity include boating, skiing, fishing and hunting. There is also a 5,000 student branch of the University system-the University of North Carolina at Wilmington-located on a new and growing campus within the county. New Hanover County, the county in which Wilmington is located, contains approximately 100,000 people.

This Position is Currently Available. All applicants should submit a cover letter, resume, a transcript of their law school activities, a significant writing sample, and the names of at least three persons who have knowledge of their abilities as an attorney or in law-related work. The salary range starts at \$13,884 and is negotiable depending upon experience. Legal Services of the Lower Cape Fear also provides a comprehensive benefits program including medical, retirement and life insurance plans.

Finalists chosen from the written submissions and recommendations and those final applicants whose resumes indicate strong experience and legal ability will be invited to interview. Interviews will continue until the position is filled. Legal Services of the Lower Cape Fear

is affiliated with Legal Services of North Carolina and is one of sixteen Legal Services programs in North Carolina. As a member of the statewide body, personnel of Legal Services of the Lower Cape Fear have an opportunity to partake of training and representational activities on a statewide basis. Legal Services of the Lower Cape Fear is an equal opportunity Employer, is a cooperating member with Legal Services of North Carolina's Affirmative Action Plan, and encourages minorities, women, the elderly and the handicapped to apply for this position.
