Odum Home to Break Ground on Education/Administration Center

PEMBROKE - Baptist Children's Homes of North Carolina will break ground Oct. 13 on a new 10,000 sq. ft. building to house the Odum Home campus school and administrative offices.
 BCH staff, along with elected Pembroke and Robeson County school officials, will lead a public ceremony at 3 p.m. to start construction of the Winifred Lindsay Education/Administrative Building at Odum Home, one of 12 BCH facilities statewide.
 Lindsay, 91, a retired teacher from Boiling Springs, has committed \$300,000 toward the school. A long-term family friend of hers, Joann Lutz, said, "Mrs. Lindsay's No. 1 goal in life is to help educate children. She realizes that so many poor children need a chance and she believes this project is an outstanding way to help them."
 Betty Davis Britt of Lumberton has given \$50,000 toward the building. Mrs. Britt made her gift in memory of her late husband, James Norment Britt jr., her deceased parents, Mr. and Mrs. Paul Price Davis, and her late brother Charles Bruce Davis.
 The Duke Endowment, a strong supporter of child and family education in North and South Carolina, has

committed \$100,000.
 Construction of the Winifred Lindsay Education/Administrative Building is one of the primary objectives of the \$10.1 million "Light Their Way" Campaign, currently underway by BCH. Halfway through the effort, \$6 million has been committed.
 Larry Sawyer, director of Pembroke Area Family Services for BCH, said bids have been let on the new building and he estimates costs at \$750,000. Architect is Ron Thompson of Lumberton.
 Odum Home provides a structured residential environment for teenagers with behavioral issues that prohibit them from living at home.
 The Winifred Lindsay Education/Administrative Center will increase Odum Home resident capacity by 10, to 38, because it will free dorm rooms currently used for classrooms and offices.
 Classes are offered on-campus in partnership with Robeson County Schools, which provides the teachers. The Lindsay Building will enable Odum Home to open its educational component to special Robeson County students who are not residents, but who present difficult behavioral issues in their current

schools.
 Baptist Children's Homes, which has operated Odum Homes since 1957, serves more than 1,400 children and their families each year through 12 facilities statewide, including Odum Home. BCH operates three other residential campuses, six emergency care cottages, two homes for behaviorally troubled girls, a maternity home, a home for teenage mothers and their babies, therapeutic camping and model day care.
 Odum Home was started in 1942 through the efforts of Burnt Swamp Baptist Association.
 "This project emphasizes not only our commitment to Odum Home, but to the families and children of Robeson and surrounding counties," said BCH President Michael C. Blackwell. "New construction is always thrilling. Adding to our excitement over this project is the knowledge it will help us serve more children, and serve them better.
 "Our mission is to help hurting children and heal broken families. Future generations will measure the effectiveness of the Winifred Lindsay Education/Administrative Building by the extent it better enables us to accomplish that mission. I'm confident it will have a profound effect."
